Responsibilities and Duties

- Perform all required safety checks (i.e. pre/post trip) including inspections of tractor/truck and trailer according to Department of Transportation (DOT) regulations; inspect tractor/truck and trailer to insure they meet company safety standards and take appropriate action as needed. Report all safety issues and/or repairs required.
- All necessary documentation as required by company.
- Drive and deliver customer orders according to predetermined route delivery schedule.
- Drive a tank truck/trailer to transport product in a safe, efficient, and professional manner
- Follow all site specific standard operating procedures for the loading and offloading process.
- Communicate all incidents, including safety and environmental concerns, according to company procedures.
- Follow all company guidelines regarding professional conduct when dealing with customers, fellow employees, vendors, and the motoring public.
- Must be able to work outside in all types of weather conditions.
- Maintain contact with logistics as needed and required.
- Accurately read and complete required documentation either manually or with the use of technology (bill of lading, invoices, driver logs, mileage records, reports, etc.)
- Must be able to move or lift items over 50 pounds,
- Perform any other assigned by management to support and improve the overall team operations.
